**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANTS’ MOTION TO DISMISS PURSUANT TO
CHAPTER 27 OF THE TEXAS CIVIL PRACTICE & REMEDIES CODE**

On _____, 2023, came on to be heard and considered Defendants, DallasNews Corporation and Lauren McGaughy (collectively “Defendants”) Motion to Dismiss Pursuant to Chapter 27 of the Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code (Defendants’ “Motion to Dismiss”), in the above-styled and numbered cause.

The parties appeared through their attorneys of record. After careful consideration of Defendants’ Motion to Dismiss and, the responses and replies, if any, and considering the pleadings, and the arguments presented, if any, the Court finds that the Motion to Dismiss is well taken and should be, and hereby is, in all respects GRANTED.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendants’ Motion to Dismiss is GRANTED in its entirety.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that all claims of Plaintiff against Defendants are hereby DISMISSED with prejudice in their entirety. Plaintiff shall take nothing from these claims.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that, in accordance with Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code § 27.009, Defendants are entitled to recover their attorney's fees and costs in bringing its motion to dismiss and defending against these claims. Defendants are ordered to submit evidence of its fees and costs by affidavit within 14 days from the date of this Order. Defendants shall be awarded such other and further relief to which they may be justly entitled, at law or in equity.
